

## 12. ADMISSION PROCESS

Selection Process - MBA Admission

Entrance Exam: Common Admission Test (CAT) conducted by Indian Institute of Management.

The selection process consists of following stages:

1. Shortlisting of candidates based on CAT scores
2. Personal Interview (PI) and Group Discussion (GD) for shortlisted candidates.

Academic performance of the candidate in 10<sup>th</sup> standard, 12<sup>th</sup> standard, qualifying degree and relevant work experience are the other components which are verified and given weightage during the second stage of the selection process. The final selection for the MBA programme will be based on the performance of the candidate in all the above components.

### Eligibility

Applicants should hold a minimum of Bachelor's Degree (under 10+2+3 or 4 pattern) recognized by UGC in any field including Arts, Science, Commerce, Engineering or Social Sciences. Candidates who possess ACA / ACWA / ACS qualification are also eligible to apply. They should have secured a minimum of 50% marks in their Graduate Degree / Master's Degree examination. Candidates appearing for the final Bachelor's or equivalent degree examination are also eligible to apply. Their admission will, however, be provisional till they produce proof of having passed the examination with a minimum of 50% marks, and the evidence of minimum required qualification produced, before the end of August 2019.
